## ORDER MEMORIALIZING BENCH RULINGS

Shortly after the evidentiary hearing in this case commenced on May 20, 2024, an *in camera* session was convened to address matters summarized in my May 17, 2024 Order.

During discussion *in camera*, the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority and the Horseracing Integrity Welfare Unit agreed to provide counsel for Appellant and her expert, under restricted disclosure provisions, an unredacted version of the document previously produced in redacted form. Counsel for Appellant further moved to adjourn the evidentiary hearing, and I granted the motion. Returning to the public part of the hearing, I announced the adjournment.

The parties have been instructed to *promptly* prepare and submit a proposed protective order covering the *in camera* discussion, and to report back on or before June 3, 2024 after meeting and conferring on certain matters arising during the *in camera* session.

A new date for resuming the evidentiary hearing will be considered after the parties' June 3 report.
