Thank you for your comment regarding the Federal Trade Commission's proposed consent agreement in the above-entitled proceeding. Your comment praises the Commission's action, noting among other things that the action not only addresses the respondents' situation but will raise awareness of security and privacy breaches more generally. Your comment also indicates that the relief mandated in the order "may serve as a general template" for other firms and that the order sends a strong message to companies about the importance of conducting a comprehensive risk analysis and of doing due diligence when health information is shared with service providers. We appreciate your comments.
