ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FACEBOOK, INC. TO FILE MOTION TO QUASH OR LIMIT RESPONDENT'S SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM

On June 18, 2014, nonparty Facebook, Inc. ("Facebook") filed a motion for an extension of time to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena *duces tecum* served on Facebook by Respondent John Fanning ("Motion"). Specifically, Facebook requests that the deadline for filing such motion be extended from June 20, 2014 to July 11, 2014.

In support of the Motion, Facebook states that Facebook and Respondent Fanning are planning to hold discussions regarding the scope of Fanning's document requests, Facebook's objections thereto, and the time required for Facebook to search for, review, and produce responsive documents. Facebook asserts that the requested extension will provide additional time for counsel for Facebook and Fanning to attempt to resolve issues regarding the scope of the subpoena. Facebook further asserts that counsel for Facebook has conferred with counsel for Fanning and that Fanning does not object to the proposed extension.

Based on the foregoing, Facebook's Motion is GRANTED and it is hereby ORDERED that the deadline for Facebook to file a motion to quash or limit, or otherwise respond to the subpoena duces tecum issued by Respondent, is hereby extended to July 11, 2014.
