## **COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S NOTICE WITHDRAWING** MOTION TO COMPEL RESPONSES TO COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM TO RICHARD EDWARD WALLACE AND TO **POSTPONE RESUMPTION OF THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

Complaint Counsel hereby gives notice that it withdraws its Motion to Compel Responses to Complaint Counsel's Subpoena Duces Tecum to Richard Edward Wallace and to Postpone Resumption of the Evidentiary Hearing ("Motion"), because Mr. Wallace has completed his production of documents responsive to the Subpoena Duces Tecum ("Subpoena").

Complaint Counsel filed its Motion on February 2, 2015. On February 12, 2015, counsel for Richard Wallace filed an Opposition stating that they expected to produce Mr. Wallace's final production of responsive documents the following day, February 13, 2015. On February 13, 2015, counsel for Mr. Wallace produced approximately 30 additional documents responsive to the Subpoena to Mr. Wallace, along with a cover letter representing that Mr. Wallace's February 13, 2015 production combined with his initial production constitute all responsive material in Mr. Wallace's possession, custody, or control.

In light of Mr. Wallace's final production and his counsel's representation that he has produced all responsive documents, Complaint Counsel no longer requires the relief sought from the Court in its Motion. Complaint Counsel therefore respectfully withdraws its Motion to

Compel Responses to Complaint Counsel's Subpoena *Duces Tecum* to Richard Edward Wallace and to Postpone Resumption of the Evidentiary Hearing.
