



# FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION FLEET MANAGEMENT COMPLIANCE REPORT

On May 24, 2011, the President issued a Memorandum directing Federal agencies to implement Government-wide fleet management practices that will reduce gas use in Federal fleet vehicles. In order to assist with the Administration's Federal fleet performance objective, and to certify that all agencies are compliant with the Executive Order 13514, the President directed in part, the following:

All new light duty vehicles leased or purchased by agencies must be alternative fueled vehicles, such as hybrid or electric, compressed natural gas, or biofuel. Therefore any executive fleet vehicle that is larger than a midsize sedan or do not comply with alternative fueled vehicle requirements must be disclosed on agency websites.

In compliance with the above requirement, the Federal Trade Commission has identified three vehicles which meet the description of an "Executive Fleet." This is identified as larger than a midsize sedan or does not comply with alternative fueled vehicle requirements, this compliance report serves as the Agency's requirement to disclose the required information to the public.

**\* The purchase of Alternative Fuel Vehicles to replace the existing non-compliant fleet will be completed by the end of the 3rd quarter of fiscal year 2012.**
