- *Your proposal for the requirement of a 7-day waiting period:*

The prospect can start the same time they see the opportunity and develop that potential from his/her own circle of friend and family and start being productive immediately. I have had prospect that registered a variety of prospects and later they realized that the Quixtar opportunity was not for then and quixtar refunded their money.*

- *The requirement to provide references:*

*The business is developed based on the friendship and commitment. List of potential prospects of not know individuals will not be effective and will change the enthusiasm of a team. Beside it would be in conflict with the violation of privacy. The group dynamic will give the prospect the opportunity to develop self and learn about other's experiences. When prospect get registered and goes to first day of IBO get recognitions as well as any other level of achievement.*

*Requirement to provide a "Litigation List":*

*At the original interview the prospect ask numerous questions about my self or the team. There are not hidden rules or knowledge.*

- *I request and propose to eliminate the waiting period, at least for opportunities like Quixtar where a prospect can get his money back if not satisfied.*
- *Eliminate the requirement to disclose past litigation*
- *IBOs should possess substantiation for any claim but should not be required to disclose it except when required by the FTC and similar state agencies in an agency investigation*
