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Subject: Response to Business Opportunity Rule, R511993.

I and my wife have been a Quixtar IBOs from over 10 years now. We have achieved some of our goals thru this business. One of them is to be an owner of business, without the hassle of other conventional businesses. Secondly to be able to give a choice to my wife to stay home most time & support me in building this business, instead of going out and working and leaving kids at babysitters. She was able to teach and train our kids, instead of just depending on School to provide this. Schools are doing their best, but it has to be supported by parents and this business was able to teach us that, thru their education system of IBOs. We were able to move into a better neighborhood and drive nicer cars due to income from this business. The biggest non-monitory goal that we have achieved thru this business, is that we are good Husband/wife to each other and parents to our kids, good friends to our friends, good kids to our parents, good person to the community and hence to the country.

When we joined, our sponsors gave us enough information and gave us chance to decide whether we want to join or not. We took about 2-3 months to decide and they never forced us to make any decision. And told us that, we can get out of business without any hassle, if we want to. Hence, I do the same with my own team. I get them into this business, only after they understand what we have in this business and what they can achieve and what is the effort required. I also mention to them, that, this is not a Get Rich Quick system, even though it looks like. It requires effort, focus and consistent effort and education. When they start the business, they understand the cost of getting started is - \$175.00 approximately, including the energy bundle product kit and their registration pack. Those who joined the team, they know, that they do not have a big risk of loosing the money, as the products are needed by every one.

The requirement that we need to wait to sponsor/register another IBOs will slow our growth in the business, as most people who want to do business, want to share it to their family and friends right away. And those family/friends want to share this awesome business to their family and friends. Most people are busy and this business is build part-time and on top of that if there is a wait time to register this business, then what do we do with people who want to do it now? This is like, telling a student who wants to register for a course, to wait as the school can register one student a week only. Sounds like some scam.

It doesn't make any sense to give list of local IBOs to a new prospective IBO. As he only knows me, my uplines and in fact, he will mostly be working with uplines. He/She can always meet other local IBOs in the group meetings that we do every week. Every week we do meetings for prospects to meet the local IBOs and the team. Then every 3-4 months they also see all IBOs in the same state at Quarterly conferences. This is more effective.

Again, it doesn't make sense, to show all litigation to a prospective IBO. Smart people anyway figure it out. If they see a good fruit on the tree, the litigation will only confuse them. When I joined a big Electric company for job, they did not bother about showing me, all the litigation all consumers had against them or all other companies had against them. If I do not want to join a company, then I should not and If I want to join and want to check myself, I can. Every one knows that, people throw stones at the tree that is bearing fruit. So, there will be cases against any successful companies written by other partners, associates and employees. That doesn't stop me doing business with them.

We don't see how the proposed rule can help Quixtar business opportunity. It will only stop or slow our growth. I recommend not to implement these rules to our business opportunities.
