

I am concerned about the proposed Business Opportunity Rule R511993. I believe in its present form, it hinders me from doing business according to the free enterprise system and could prevent me from being successful.

I started my home based direct selling business in 2005 and I can assure that it has been one of the most fulfilling experiences of my life. The selling of the nutritional products has changed my life as well as many others. Seeing people help other people is truly a rewarding experience.

The 7 day waiting period casts a negative light and causes unnecessary delays. In most companies and in mine, if someone decides they do not want the products, then a return is honored. This 7 day wait is unreasonable and is unnecessary in the protection of customers. Most businesses do not have this restriction and it would hinder my business in an unnecessary way.

The area of litigation reporting is unfair when it does not distinguish between winning and losing lawsuits.

AND FINALLY: IT IS IMPRACTICAL TO FIND 10 NEAREST DISTRIBUTORS AND IS AGAINST ALL THAT THE FREE ENTERPRISE SYSTEM IS ALL ABOUT! I work with people all over the U.S. and have developed relationships that are valuable and based on the above, and giving a customer to a distributor that is nearest them does NOT assure that person will be taken care of. The customer will be taken care of ONLY when relationships are established; NOT because the distributor lives near them. I care about each person and even though they may live far from me, through the phone and e-mail, I develop a trusting and caring relationship.

I understand there are fraudulent groups. However, the FTC's proposed rule would UNFAIRLY TARGET LEGITIMATE direct selling businesses.
