

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing to you due to my concerns about the proposed Business Opportunity Rule R511993. I fear that in its present form, this rule could prevent me from operating my business as an Independent Sunrider Distributor. I understand that the FTC has a responsibility to protect the public but also believe that this proposed ruling is overreaching and could make it impossible for me to continue to sell the Sunrider products which I have been doing for the past 23 years.

I am particularly opposed to the proposed seven-day waiting period to enroll new Distributors. This waiting period gives the impression that there may be something wrong or fraudulent about the plan. People buy products everyday that are much more expensive than the products we distribute and are not required to wait seven days.

I feel that there are several other key parts of the proposed rule that are unfairly burdensome and could be very detrimental to my ability to conduct my business. My family depends on the extra income derived from our Sunrider Distributorship.

I hope that you will seek other alternative ways to achieve your goals and objectives of protecting the public from what you see as unfair and deceptive practices.
