Re: FTC Proposed "Business Opportunity Rule" R511993

Dear Mrs. Waite:

Enclosed is a letter I wrote at the request of Sunrider International to the FTC expressing my concerns about the proposed Rule R511993. My wife and I have had a successful network marketing business with Sunrider for 16 years. According to the Sunrider manager, Rule R511993 provides for the following:

- *Distributors holding an Opportunity Meeting would have to wait a full seven days before they could sponsor any of the attendees, even those who are eager to join Sunrider and begin their Sunrider businesses immediately.*
- *Distributors making claims about their income must provide an "Earning Claims Statement" to prospective Distributors seven days before they join as Distributors. This must be extensive and regularly updated.*
- *Distributors would be required to provide prospects a detailed "Disclosure Statement" including information such as previous lawsuits against the company (Regardless of outcome), and the number of Distributors who have cancelled in the previous two years.*
- *Distributors would be required to give prospects a list of "references" of Distributors geographically "closest" to them who have become Distributors in the last three years. Prospects must be advised that their personal contact information may be given as a "reference" to future prospects.*
