


Re: Business Opportunity Rule, R51193

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing this letter because I am concerned about the proposed Opportunity Rule 511993. I believe that in its presented form, it could prevent me from continuing as a distributor for XanGo. I also believe that the rules proposed are grossly unfair and would frankly, ruin my very small but enjoyable business.

I became a XanGo distributor a year ago because I saw how much mangosteen juice helped my mother feel better (in fact both my sister's became distributors as well for this very reason). I am a stay at home mother and community volunteer. Being a XanGo distributor allows me to contribute to our families' income but not take me away from my job of raising our children and volunteering in my community.

Some of the sections in the proposed rule would make it very hard for me to sell XanGo. For example, the waiting period that is proposed. This seems quite unfair. A consumer can go to Whole Foods or Costco and buy mangosteen juice immediately. However if someone wanted to buy it from me they would have to wait days!

XanGo actually protects the consumer as much or more than Costco and Whole Foods because there is a 30 day money back guarantee.

Also, the proposed rule requires the disclosure of a minimum of 10 prior purchasers living nearest to the prospective purchaser. I am always happy to provide references however because of privacy concerns (and indeed ID theft concerns) how could I possibly routinely give out names and phone numbers to people who may be strangers to each other?

In conclusion, this is the very first time I have ever written a government agency regarding anything. I am writing you today because this proposed Opportunity Rule seems so "anti-American", "anti-small business", and "anti-women who wish to stay at home to raise their children and yet make a little income."
