

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am a very concerned businessman who is involved in the network marketing industry representing 2 different companies. I am proud of the services and products we provide for our clients. My wife and I have worked very hard to develop a new source of income and to offer many people goods and services that are of high quality. We are proud Americans and enjoy the privilege self employment, a privilege found only in the United States. The Business Opportunity Rule, R511993, could prevent me from doing business as a direct marketer and would take from us the freedom that we as Americans share under the United States Constitution.

The 7 day waiting period is especially troublesome. People buy cars, televisions, furniture, etc. daily and have no 7 day waiting period. I am also a loan officer and secure home loans for home buyers who do not have a 7 day waiting period on the largest purchase of their lifetime. It seems absurd to place a waiting period on voluntary purchases that are far less significant!

The volume of additional paperwork created by this Rule, R511993, would overwhelm our home and drive us out of these business ventures that provide additional income for us and thousands of other network marketers nationwide. We rely on this income as does everyone who enjoys network marketing. Why would government intervention want to subdue this great industry with unnecessary legislation?

I greatly value the diligent work of the FTC, but I strongly believe there are many unintended negative consequences that will accompany this new legislation. Please hear from the people and do not pass this rule R 511993; it will be detrimental to a large population of hard working and industrious Americans.
