ConocoPhillips was required to dispose of the Woods Cross Refinery because of concerns of the FTC. Since that message the employees here have been told by representatives of the company that they would get certain benefits. This has not become the case. Going to the meetings and reviewing the benefit plans, the health, welfare and moral of the workforce is obviously not one of the major considerations.

Statements were made to us that mentioned our Retirement plans and others would be handled in a manner that would represent the 29 years plus I have worked here for Phillips Petroleum. The retirement plan, the taking away of the Social Security offset, etc. have eliminated equality for the planned retirement I figured with Phillips Petroleum and the very much lessor one I'm being relegated to.

I no longer believe that the FTC is actually concerned with the actual market along the Wasatch Front. So I don't understand their order to sell this refinery. All decisions, along with the recent one of Holly Corp. putting the service stations on the block don't point to concern for market conditions, health, safety and welfare of the employees and people along the Wasatch Front.
