I am writing in response to the upcoming sale of the Woods Cross assets by ConocoPhillip's to Holly Corp. It is FTC File No. 021-0040, Docket No. C-4058.

I am very concerned with how ConocoPhillip's is handling the employees at the Woods Cross refinery. They are giving the non represented employees a retirement bonus called Workforce Stabilization but they aren't offering this same bonus to the represented employees. This seems very discriminatory to me.

Also Holly Corp is supposed to match our benefits but as of now on the matching part of employee savings plans they are way behind what ConocoPhillip's offered. We were getting a 9.25 to 1 match and Holly is only offering a 4 to 1 match. This isn't right.
