#### THIRD JOINT STATUS REPORT

On January 12, 2005, this court issued an order granting in part and denying in part
Respondents' motion to stay these proceedings. The court's order provided that this proceeding
be stayed until entry of a formal sentence in Vincent Chhabra's federal court proceeding in
Virginia. The court's order also required the parties to file updated joint status reports every
twenty one days covering the anticipated sentencing date of Mr. Chhabra and the status of
settlement negotiations. Pursuant to the court's order, the parties hereby file their joint status
report.

# **Complaint Counsel's Statement**

Since the filing of the last Joint Status Report on February 16, 2005, there has been very little progress in Mr. Chhabra's criminal proceeding in Virginia. Complaint Counsel has been informed that the parties in that matter are still attempting to resolve certain outstanding matters regarding Mr. Chhabra's compliance with the terms of his plea agreement. No new sentencing

date has been set.

Also, since the filing of our last Joint Status Report, Counsel for Respondents has agreed to a settlement meeting between the parties that includes FTC management and Respondent Vineet Chhabra. Due to scheduling conflicts, that meeting has not yet occurred. However, it does appear that the meeting will take place on April 6, 2005.

### **Statement of Counsel for Respondents**

Respondents incorporate by reference Respondents' assertions in the prior status reports. The parties have a tentative date of April 6, 2005 to meet in Florida with Mr. Chhabra to discuss the merits of the case as well as pursue settlement discussions.
