## <u>COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND</u> SCHEDULING ORDER AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT THEREOF

Complaint Counsel respectfully moves the Court for an order amending the October 26, 2010 Scheduling Order to permit the parties to serve requests for admission ("RFAs") no later than February 25, 2011.

The Scheduling Order currently requires the parties to serve RFAs no later than January 14, 2011. The proposed amendment would change the January 14, 2011 deadline to February 25, 2011, which is one week after the close of discovery. Responses to the RFAs would be due ten days later on March 7, 2011, pursuant to Rule 3.32(b).

As in *Intel Corporation*, FTC Docket No. 9341, Complaint Counsel believes that it will benefit significantly if permitted to extend the deadline for serving RFAs to no later than February 25, 2011. *See* Order Granting Joint Motion to Amend Scheduling Order (Apr. 30, 2010). In this case, the parties anticipate that most, if not all, of the fact depositions of Respondents will take place between January 14, 2011 and the close of discovery on February 18, 2011. Thus, the parties would benefit by serving RFAs shortly after the close of discovery, in

order to avoid issuing unnecessary RFAs. Further, the proposed change would not affect any other deadlines prescribed by the Scheduling Order, including the Commencement of Hearing on May 24, 2011. Complaint Counsel represents that it has conferred with Respondents, and on December 23, 2010 opposing counsel stated to Complaint Counsel that Respondents do not object to this proposal.
