Dear Ms. Wallace:

As you know, upon referral from the National Advertising Division of the Council of Better Business Bureaus ("NAD"), the staff of the Federal Trade Commission's Division of Advertising Practices has conducted an investigation into whether PatentHEALTH, LLC ("PatentHEALTH"), violated Sections 5(a) and 12 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 45(a) and 52, through the use of false and misleading advertising in connection with the sale of the dietary supplement Trigosamine. Specifically, NAD's referral concerned the advertorial format of the advertising campaign for Trigosamine and whether PatentHEALTH possessed competent and reliable scientific evidence to substantiate certain claims regarding the supplement.

Upon review of the matter, we have determined not to take additional action at this time. This action is not to be construed as a determination that a violation did not occur. The Commission reserves the right to take such further action as the public interest may require.
