Thank you for your comments regarding the proposed consent order accepted by the Federal Trade Commission for public comment in the above-captioned matter. The Commission has placed your comment on the public record pursuant to Rule 4.9(b)(6)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 4.9(b)(6)(ii). As we understand your comment, you have concerns about Hertz Global Holdings, Inc.'s ("Hertz") ownership of Dollar Thrifty Automotive Group, Inc. ("Dollar Thrifty") while it still owned and operated Advantage Rent A Car ("Advantage"). The Commission has reviewed your comments in connection with its decision concerning whether to accord final approval to the proposed consent order.

Under the terms of the Decision and Order, Hertz has a limited amount of time after acquiring a majority of the shares of Dollar Thrifty to divest, among other things, the Advantage Rent A Car locations. Post-divestiture, consumers will benefit from competition between the independent Advantage locations and Hertz. In light of these considerations, among others, the Commission has determined that the public interest would best be served by issuing the Decision and Order as final.
