ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO SUSPEND DEADLINES

Having considered the Parties’ Joint Expedited Motion to Suspend Scheduling Order Deadlines, and to alleviate the burden on non-parties, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. All pre-hearing deadlines contained in the Scheduling Order in this matter are hereby suspended.
2. If Respondents’ Corrected Motion to Continue Evidentiary Hearing is denied, or if the Evidentiary Hearing is otherwise unable to commence on December 4, 2024, then the Parties shall submit a joint proposal amending the current Scheduling Order within two business days.
3. If Respondents’ Corrected Motion to Continue Evidentiary Hearing is granted, within ten business days after the completion of the preliminary injunction hearing in *Federal Trade Commission v. Tempur Sealy Int’l, Inc.*, No. 4:24-cv-02508 (S.D. Tex.), the Parties shall submit a joint status report advising this Court on their position regarding whether and how to amend the Scheduling Order.
