**ORDER DIRECTING JOINT STATUS REPORT**

The Commission’s October 29, 2024 Order granted the parties’ joint motion for a continuance, reset the commencement of the evidentiary hearing for August 18, 2025, and extended all pre-hearing deadlines in this proceeding by four months. This four-month stay will expire on March 3, 2025.<sup>1</sup>

The parties are hereby directed to file, by February 21, 2025, a joint status report: (1) advising this Court of any settlement discussions; (2) providing any updates on the federal
