

On March 5, 2025, Plaintiff the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") and Defendants Growth Cave, LLC, Apex Mind, LLC, Lucas Lee-Tyson, and Osmany Batte (collectively, "Stipulating Defendants") submitted a Joint Stipulation to Continue Show Cause Hearing and Extend Temporary Restraining Order. The Court having considered the Joint Stipulation and, good cause appearing, the Court GRANTS the Joint Stipulation and ORDERS as follows:

- 1. By consent of the parties, the Temporary Restraining Order is hereby extended through March 26, 2025;
- 2. The Temporary Restraining Order is amended to allow Mr. Batte to spend up to \$30,000 per month in reasonable living expenses including mortgage payments, utilities, food, childcare expenses, medical expenses, and car payments;
- 3. The Temporary Restraining Order is amended to allow Mr. Lee-Tyson to spend up to \$44,000 per month in reasonable living expenses including mortgage payments, utilities, taxes, food, and medical expenses;
- 4. The Show Cause Hearing set for March 5, 2025 is hereby continued to March 26, 2025 at 8:30AM; 7:30 AM
- 5. Stipulating Defendants shall file any brief regarding the preliminary injunction by no later than March 19, 2025;
- 6. The FTC shall file any brief responding to the Stipulating Defendants' brief by no later than March 24, 2025;
- 7. To the extent the FTC and the Stipulating Defendants are able to stipulate to a proposed preliminary injunction, the Court will vacate the Show Cause Hearing set for March 26, 2025 and no appearance is required.
